# Frequently Asked Questions

<p><b>Where is my classroom?</b></p>	<p>Make sure the student is at the right campus first for that particular class! Double check the Section Number, the letter of which indicates the campus. Send them to Advising (F109) if they need to resolve campus schedule issues.</p>
<p><b>Do I need a parking sticker?</b></p>	<p>Yes. Students can get their free parking stickers at the Student Engagement Office in Alumni Hall (A185).</p>
<p><b>Do I have to have a student ID card?</b></p>	<p>Yes. You cannot use the Lab, Testing Center, Fitness Center, etc. without it. It also doubles as your library card.</p>
<p><b>Where do I get my student ID?</b></p>	<p>IDs are made in the Student Engagement Office (A185).</p>
<p><b>I want to <u>add</u> and <u>drop</u> a class. What do I need to do?</b></p>	<p>Students can add classes online up to the 4<sup>th</sup> day of the semester. They should see Advising (F109) if they have questions. Drops and withdrawals – including total withdrawal - are done online through student’s CougarWeb account.</p>
<p><b>What is the difference between “L” and “LH”?</b></p>	<p>All classes with LH are in Lawler Hall. All classes with L are in the library. Any classes in library on the first floor can be accessed by a separate entrance on the east side of the library. You cannot get there by going into the library itself.</p>
<p><b>Where is there a computer I can use?</b></p>	<p>The student can go to the Computer Lab (H120) or Library (1<sup>st</sup> floor) to use a computer. There are also a few computers in F109 for add/drop schedule look-up.</p>
<p><b>I want to add a class, but it is full. What do I need to do?</b></p>	<p>Look for options at different times and locations. Overloads are an exception. For <b><u>consideration</u></b> of such an exception, have them contact the appropriate division office (Academic Associate Dean).</p> <p>*Math &amp; Natural Sciences DOES NOT allow overloads.*</p>
<p><b>There is nothing on my schedule now! What happened? What can I do?</b></p>	<p>Chances are they forgot to pay and were dropped from all their classes. Tell student to go online and re-register. If student paid &amp; thinks that there is a mistake, then send them to the Cashier’s office (F110).</p>
<p><b>My class was canceled and I need another class. What do I do?</b></p>	<p>First make certain the cancellation on the door is the correct class. Students can add classes on-line through the 4th class day. Course Cancellations=100% refund</p>
<p><b>I went to my class but it was the wrong class or no one was there.</b></p>	<p>Check to make sure the student isn’t in an evening class instead of a morning class or vice versa. Also check to make sure he/she is on the correct campus.</p>

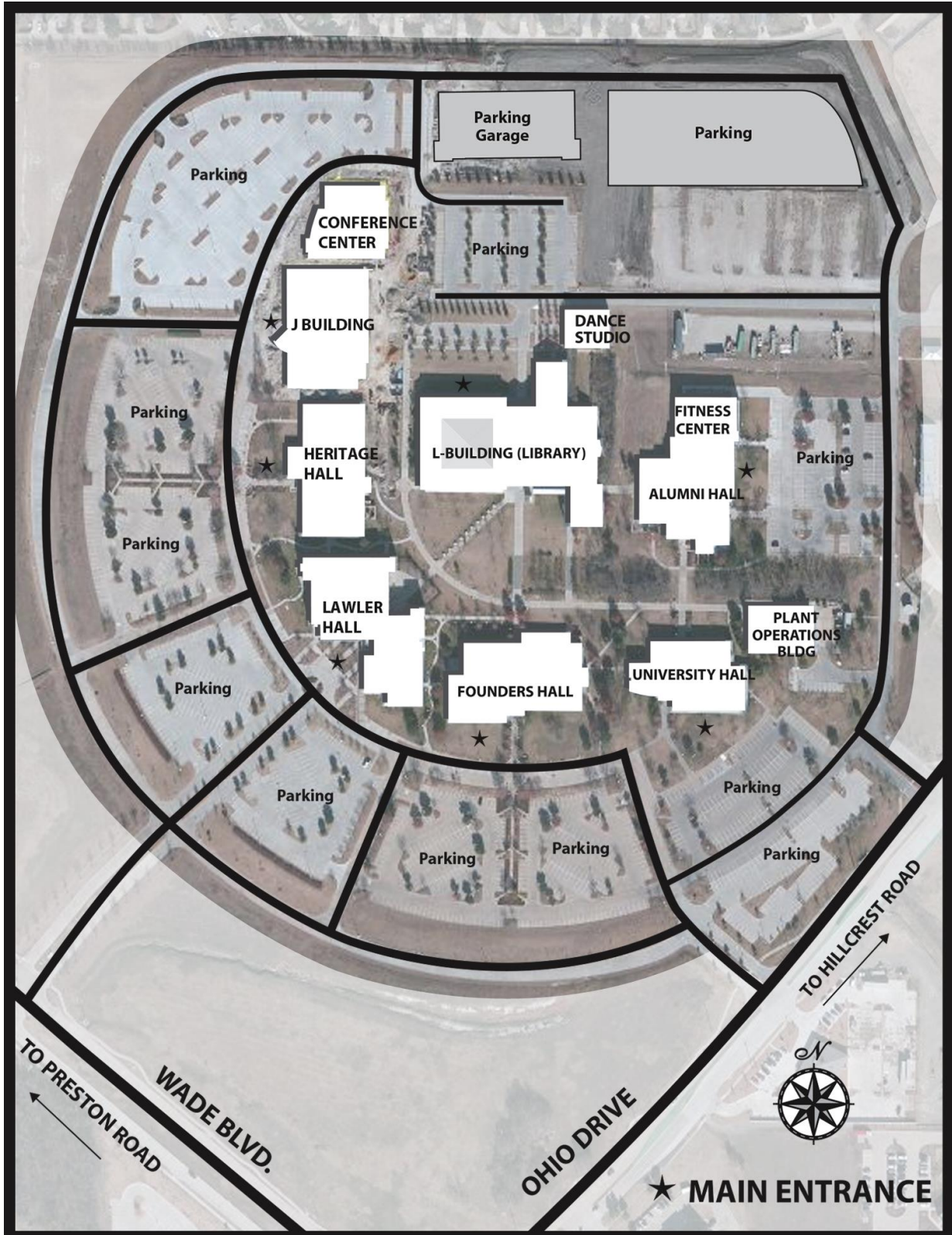
